

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

College Ministry

In this course you will discover effective ways to reach young adults on college campuses. The focus will include: biblical topics that are relevant to college age students, methods used to attract college students, and effective teaching methods.

Exegesis I

In this course you will learn the process of studying the meaning of text in the Bible in order to discover its significance and relevance.

Exegesis II

In this course you will actually apply the process you learned in Exegesis I by giving formal presentations and critiquing the presentations of your classmates.

Faith I

This course will explore the fundamental principles of faith and its importance in the Kingdom of God.

Faith II

This course will explore the keys to obtaining strong faith.

Faith III

This course will explore how to develop and walk by faith.

Faith IV

This course will explore faith in action in the Old Testament.

Faith V

This course will explore faith in action in the gospels.

Hermeneutics I

This course will explore the process of obtaining meaning from the Bible by taking a comprehensive look at the social, cultural, economic and political factors at the time the events in the Bible took place.

Hermeneutics II

In this course you will actually apply the process you learned in Hermeneutics I by giving formal presentations and critiquing the presentations of your classmates.

Holy Spirit I

This course will focus on the study of the person and power of the Holy Spirit and his function in the Kingdom of God.

Holy Spirit II

This course will focus on the study of how to be led by the Holy Spirit in everyday life.

Holy Spirit III

This course will focus on the study of the Fruit of the Spirit.

Holy Spirit IV

This course will focus on the study of the Gifts of the Spirit.

Holy Spirit V

This course will focus on the study of the Holy Spirit's work throughout the Bible.

Inner Circle

In this course you will observe and learn a biblical approach to addressing drug and alcohol addiction. You will attend sessions of those struggling with an addiction and/or in the early stages of recovery. Due to the confidential nature of this course this course has additional admission requirements and is not available to everyone. (Confidentiality agreements must be signed PRIOR to enrolling in this course.)

Kingdom I

This course will study understanding the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom II

This course will study citizenship in the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom III

This course will study Lordship in the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom IV

This course will study the Kingdom of God compared to democracy and religion.

Kingdom V

This course will focus on how to teach Kingdom Principles

Leadership I

This course will study the fundamental principles of leadership.

Leadership II

This course will study the essentials for leadership development.

Leadership III

This course will study the qualities of good leaders.

Leadership IV

This course will study how to assist as a leader of a helps ministry.

Leadership V

This course will teach how to give leadership of a leadership ministry

Leadership VI

This course will focus on how to teach leadership principles

Marriage Ministry

This course will examine the biblical standards for marriage. The course will focus on God's original intent for marriage, how the Bible deals with divorce, and activities for married couples to participate in.

Men's Ministry

In this course you will learn how the Bible deals with issues pertinent to men. This course examines the role of men as the leaders of their families and how to become the man that God intended for you to be by applying the Word of God to real life everyday situations.

Mentor Ministry

This course will teach the fundamentals of mentoring as ministry. You will study mentors in the Bible and learn how mentoring can enhance your ministry.

Multimedia Ministry

This course will examine how modern technology and social media can be used as a forum to spread the gospel and reach people in a variety of ways.

New Testament I

This course provides a verse by verse study of John. You will receive background information on each book.

New Testament II

This course provides a verse by verse study of Acts. You will receive background information on each book.

New Testament III

This course provides a verse by verse study of Romans. You will receive background information on each book.

New Testament IV

This course provides a verse by verse study of Ephesians. You will receive background information on each book.

New Testament V

This course provides a verse by verse study of James. You will receive background information on each book.

Old Testament I

This course provides a verse by verse study of Genesis. You will receive background information on each book.

Old Testament II

This course provides a verse by verse study of Joshua. You will receive background information on each book.

Old Testament III

This course provides a verse by verse study of Psalms. You will receive background information on each book.

Old Testament IV

This course provides a verse by verse study of Proverbs. You will receive background information on each book.

Old Testament V

This course provides a verse by verse study of Isaiah. You will receive background information on each book.

Outreach Ministry

This course will provide hands on experience with ministering to those in need in their own environment. Students will actually accompany their instructor to poverty stricken areas in the community to provide immediate short term relief to those in need. This course will focus on: establishing services in the heart of poverty stricken communities, effective methods to reach people in poverty stricken communities, and partnering with local agencies to serve the community. (Prereq RES 1)

Prayer I

This course will explore the fundamentals of prayer. You will learn the importance of prayer and why it is necessary in the lives as believers.

Prayer II

This course will explore the format of prayer through an in-depth study of "The Lord's Prayer." At the conclusion of this course students will be familiar with the correct way to pray to God individually.

Prayer III

This course focuses on the importance of prayer in the lives of leaders in ministry. The course will include a study of Biblical leaders who engaged in prayer regularly throughout their ministry.

Prayer IV

This course will focus on the importance of corporate prayer. You will learn why corporate prayer is necessary and how to conduct corporate prayer.

Prayer V

This class will be a hands-on course in conducting corporate prayer. Students will be expected to lead and facilitate corporate prayer sessions.

Prison Ministry

This course will provide hands on experience with ministering to men and women who are incarcerated. Students will actually travel with their instructor to prison for ministry sessions. (Prereq RES 1) Topics include: what to expect when entering a prison, prison rules and regulations for ministry, how to effectively minister to inmates, biblical study of prisoners in the bible, and how to biblically prepare prisoners for reentry into society.

Restoration I

“Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me” (Matt 25:40 KJV) This course will examine Restoration as taught by Jesus. It will explore the biblical basis and examples of restoring lives and why it is our duties as believers to take on these endeavors.

Restoration II

In this course you will encounter hands on experience with individuals seeking to turn their lives around. This course will focus on the complete intake process that includes helping an individual understand the Kingdom approach to restoring his or her life, assessing the needs of an individual, pairing an individual with a mentor, and connecting an individual to services needed within the community. (PREREQ:RES 1)

Restoration III

In this course you will learn how mentoring plays a vital role in restoring the lives of individuals who have fallen by the wayside. You will learn the importance of a mentor, what is required of a mentor and how to become a mentor. (PREREQ:RES 1)

Restoration IV

In this course you will learn how to effectively run and operate a restoration program. You will receive intense training as it relates to how to locate your clientele, how to fund your program, how to select your clientele, how to manage residential facilities, daily schedules for clientele, etc. (PREREQ:RES 1,2,3)

Restoration V

In this course you will learn how to legally establish a Restoration Program. This course will include the various types of legal entities available to establish your program under, how to apply for separate tax-exempt status and/or how to charter as a member of The Restoration Program, Inc.. (PREREQ:RES 1,2,3,4)

Restoration VI

In this course students will receive hands-on training in how to run a Restoration Program.

Restoration Bible Study

This class will provide students with methods for conducting Bible Study geared towards who are in need of restoring their lives due to addictions, criminal convictions, etc.

Singles Ministry

This class will provide lessons in effective methods to minister to single individuals who desire a mate.

Studying the Bible I – (Keys to Effective Bible Study)

In this course students will learn the keys necessary to be effective in the study of the Bible and how to use the Bible tools.

Studying the Bible II – (Study of Individual Books)

In this course students will study individual books of the Bible in order to gain truth from each particular book.

Studying the Bible III

This course will focus on the study of topics in the Bible and how to apply them to everyday living.

Studying the Bible IV - Bible Characters

The course will involve the study of individuals from the Bible. Students will learn the character traits, backgrounds and reputations and of each Bible character in order to discover what can be learned about God from the character study.

Studying the Bible V

This course will focus on how to effectively teach others how to study the Bible.

Symbolism

This course will explore how people, places and things are used throughout the Bible as a representation of deeper meanings. You will learn how recognizing symbolism within the Bible can impact your understanding and study of the Bible.

Women's Ministry

In this course you will learn how the Bible deals with issues pertinent to women. This course examines the role of women as the help mates in their families and how to become the woman that God intended for you to be by applying the Word of God to real life everyday situations.

Youth Ministry

This course will teach you how to expose children and young believers to the Love of God, to encourage them to honor God with their lives and serve in His Kingdom, and to unite them with other believers.
